


# Steampunk

## Teen Fiction Suggested Reading List

All titles located in YA Fiction or YA Paperbacks by the author's last name.



**Ship Breaker** by Paolo Bacigalupi

A tale set in a Gulf Coast shanty town 100 years in the future finds teen Nailer dreaming of a better life on the sea before discovering a beached clipper ship and lone survivor. (Grades 7 & up)



**Clockwork Angel** by Cassandra Clare

Tessa Fell's search for her missing brother leads her into Victorian London's supernatural underworld, where she must learn to trust the demon-killing Shadowhunters if she wants to learn to control her powers and find her brother. (Grades 8 & up)




**Un Lun Dun** by China Mieville

Stumbling into an alternate funhouse version of her home city, twelve-year-old Londoner Deeba finds herself trapped in a world of killer giraffes, animated umbrellas, and ghost children, and must take on the role of savior to prevent utter destruction. (Grades 7 & up)




**Airborn\*** by Kenneth Oppel

Matt, a young cabin boy aboard an airship, and Kate, a wealthy young girl traveling with her chaperone, team up to search for the existence of mysterious winged creatures reportedly living hundreds of feet above the Earth's surface. (Grades 7 & up)



**Golden Compass\*** by Philip Pullman

Living among scholars in the hallowed halls of Jordan College, Lyra hears rumors of a magical dust that supposedly possesses powers that can unite whole universes, and begins a dangerous journey to find it. (Grades 7 & up)



**Mortal Engines: A Novel\*** by Philip Reeve

In London, which is now a huge 7-tiered city comprised of metal, Tom, a lowly apprentice, saves the life of Thaddeus Valentine, a renowned architect, only to find himself left for dead in a sea of mud, in an epic story of intrigue, betrayal, and Municipal Darwinism. (Grades 7 & up)



**The Hunchback Assignments\*** by Arthur Slade

The mysterious Mr. Socrates rescues Modo, a child with an amazing ability to transform his appearance, and raises him to be a spy. It's up to 14-year-old Modo and fellow spy Octavia Milkweed to save their country from the diabolical efforts of a mad scientist. (Grade 7 & up)



**Around the World in Eighty Days** by Jules Verne

In 1872 Phileas Fogg wins a bet by traveling around the world in seventy-nine days, twenty-three hours, and fifty-seven minutes. (Grades 7 & up)



**Leviathan\*** by Scott Westerfeld

In an alternate 1914 Europe, Austrian Prince Alek, on the run from forces who are attempting to take over the globe with machinery, forms an alliance with Deryn, who is learning to fly genetically-engineered beasts. (Grades 7 & up)



**The Haunting of Azaizabel Cray** by Chris Wooding

In a world similar to Victorian London, Thaniel, a seventeen-year-old hunter of deadly, demonic creatures called the wych-kin, takes in a lost, possessed girl, and becomes embroiled in a plot to unleash evil on the world. (Grade 8 & up)
